



Media Statement – Outbreak over at Humber Valley Terrace Long Term Care Home – Etobicoke

We received notice on October 7 from Toronto Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Humber Valley Terrace Long Term Care Home in Etobicoke is over.

We appreciate the support of Toronto Public Health, our families and the local community as we worked to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected. As Toronto is in a designated hot zone for community spread of COVID-19, all visits have been cancelled, except for essential caregiver visit and essential visitors to palliative residents.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
