



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Hunt Club Manor Retirement Residence – Ottawa

Ottawa Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Hunt Club Manor Retirement Residence in Ottawa to be over as of today. One staff member had tested positive for COVID-19 and is now recovered. No residents or other staff of Hunt Club Manor were involved in the outbreak.

We appreciate the support of Ottawa Public Health and the patience and understanding of the families of our residents. We would also like to acknowledge the hard work of the team at Hunt Club Manor who continue to work hard to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks and eye protection at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
