



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Victoria Place Retirement Residence – Kitchener

Waterloo Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Victoria Place Retirement Residence in Kitchener, over on October 25. The third-party care provider who tested positive for COVID-19 is now recovered.

We appreciate the support of Waterloo Public Health and the patience and understanding of the families of our residents. We would also like to acknowledge the hard work of the team at Victoria Place who continue to work hard to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear appropriate masks and eye protection at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
