



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Scenic Acres Retirement Residence – Calgary

We received notice yesterday from Alberta Health Services (AHS) that the COVID-19 outbreak at Scenic Acres in Calgary is over. The outbreak was declared on September 3. During this outbreak, four residents and three staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. We regret to report that one resident has passed away with COVID-19. The team at Scenic Acres offers its most sincere condolences to the family and friends of the resident who passed away.

We appreciate the support of AHS, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. All staff are required to wear appropriate personal protective equipment in the home.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over. Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
