



**Media Statement – Update on COVID-19 Outbreak at Scenic Acres Retirement Residence –
Calgary**

Since Alberta Health Services declared an outbreak Scenic Acres retirement residence on September 3, we've received confirmation that three residents and three staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. All staff cases are considered resolved.

We regret to inform we have had one resident pass away with COVID-19. The team at Scenic Acres offers its most sincere condolences to the family and friends of the resident who passed away

We continue to work closely with Alberta Health Services officials to implement pandemic outbreak protocols and infection control practices. Residents are monitored for symptoms twice daily. All staff are screened at the beginning and end of their shifts and are required to wear a surgical mask and eye protection in the residence at all times.

We continue to do enhanced cleaning at Scenic Acres, disinfecting high touch surfaces like handrails and doors, common areas and staff rooms frequently.

We have informed residents, their families and the staff of the status of the outbreak.

Revera continues to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
