



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Donway Place Retirement Residence – Toronto

We were notified by Toronto Public Health today that the COVID-19 outbreak at Donway Place Retirement Residence in Toronto has been declared over. The outbreak did not involve the residents of Don Mills Seniors Apartments.

Once again, we offer our deepest sympathies for the resident who passed away after testing positive for COVID-19. Five staff members also tested positive and their cases are resolved.

We would like to thank Toronto Public Health and Michael Garron Hospital for their support during the outbreak. We appreciate the patience and understanding of the families of our residents. We would also like to acknowledge the hard work of the entire team at Donway Place who continue to work hard to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
