



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Northridge Long Term Care – Oakville

Earlier today, Halton Region Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Northridge Long Term Care Home in Oakville to be over. The outbreak involved one staff member who tested positive for COVID-19 and was limited to one of the home's five resident areas.

We want to express our gratitude for the support we have received from the families of our residents and Halton Region Public Health.

We want to assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks in the home at all times and follow pandemic infection control practices.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

We will continue to follow all Ministry of Long Term Care directives and Halton Region Public Health protocols.

We are in the process of reaching out to families of residents in the affected home area regarding the resumption of visits.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
