

Media Statement – Outbreak over at Bow Crest Long Term Care Home – Calgary - Dr. Rhonda Collins, Chief Medical Officer, Revera

September 12, 2021

Alberta Health Services (AHS) has declared the outbreak at Bow Crest long term care home over. The outbreak was declared on August 28 after two staff members tested positive for COVID-19. Those cases are now resolved.

Residents and families have been informed that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected by the outbreak.

We appreciate the support of AHS and the patience and understanding of the families of our residents. We would also like to acknowledge the hard work of the team at Bow Crest who continue to work hard to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear appropriate masks and eye protection at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
