



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Meadowlands Retirement Residence – Medicine Hat

Alberta Health Services (AHS) has declared the outbreak at Meadowlands retirement residence over. The outbreak was declared on August 12 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. The case has now resolved.

Residents and families have been informed that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected by the outbreak.

We appreciate the support of AHS and the patience and understanding of the families of our residents. We would also like to acknowledge the hard work of the team at Meadowlands who continue to work hard to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear appropriate masks and eye protection at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
